Founded in 2016, Overseas Chinese Academy of Concord Suzhou (OCAC, formerly Overseas Chinese Academy of Chiway Suzhou) is a private boarding and day school offering a 15-year education from kindergarten to high school to 2100 students. OCAC was established to better meet the international education needs of the children of overseas Chinese returnees, leading talents and other high-level talents in China. As of 2026, 50% of our current student body comes from families with overseas returnee backgrounds, while over 70% of parents hold master's or doctoral degrees.

OCAC High School offers an English medium of instruction and provides top-quality teaching and learning experiences to students from G9 to G12. The school community collectively upholds the values of open-mindedness, courage, altruism, and collaboration to realize our mission.

CURRICULA

OCAC high school offers three curricula, IGCSE, IBDP and A Level, together with our school-based curriculum. In Grade 9-10, students embark on a bridging program of IGCSE courses. From Grade 11-12, students can choose either IBDP or A Level program. All programs are taught in English.

OCAC is proud to offer a unique and interdisciplinary enrichment program which covers a wide range of co-curricular and super-curricular activities. The enrichment program provides experiences which are a vital part of students' education and encourage them to live our mission through discovery, exploration and play in a globalized society. The programs offered in our enrichment program are led by students, teachers and outside professional providers.

Built from the ground up, students at OCAC develop critical skills and competencies in a rigorous and empowering program based on our core values: Open-minded, Courage, Altruism, and Collaboration.

GRADING SCALE

Grades are determined based on the CIE and IBO official grading rubrics:

- In Grade 9 and 10, students receive letter grades of A*-G in their IGCSE courses;
- In Grade 11 and 12, IBDP students receive number grades of 1-7 in their IB courses;
- In Grade 11 and 12, A Level students receive letter grades of A*-E in their A Level courses.

It is our philosophy neither to rank students nor to compute grade point averages (GPA).

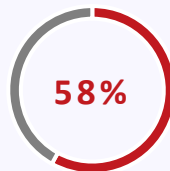
